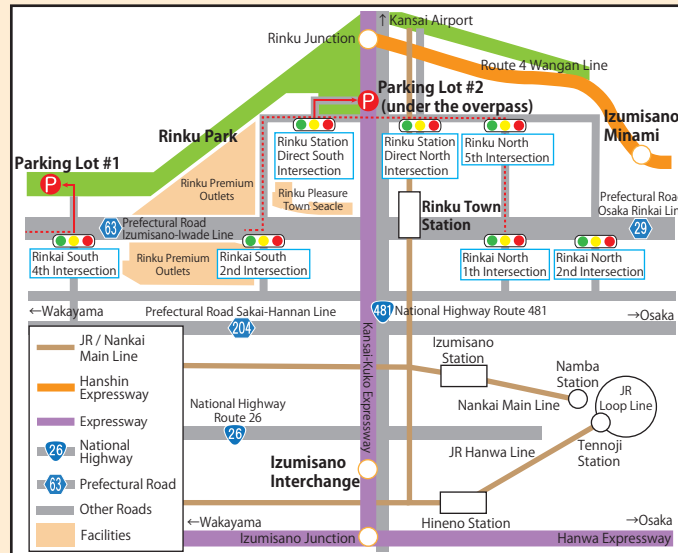

Directions to the Park



- About 250 meters from Rinku Town Station in the direction of Kansai International Airport
- About 40 minutes from JR Tennoji Station by the Kansai Airport Express
- About 37 minutes from Namba Station, Nankai Railway by the Airport Express
- About 2.9km in the direction of Kansai International Airport after exiting Kansai-kuko Expressway at the Izumisano Interchange after turning at the Hanwa Expressway Izumisano Junction
- About 1.7km in the direction of Wakayama after exiting Hanshin Highway Bayside Line at the Izumisano south ramp.
- ⚠ The parking lots in the park are paid parking.
(For more information, please check the Rinku Park website, or inquire at the management office.)

Park Rules

- Please take your trash home with you, including paper scraps and leftover lunch boxes.
- Please use self-standing type hammocks and slacklines.
If you have to tie rope to a tree, after ensuring the safety of the surroundings, please place a towel where you tie the rope to protect the tree.
- Make sure to check there are no other park guests nearby before flying kites at Marble Beach.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash and owners are responsible for picking up waste left by their dogs.
- Please refrain from swimming at Marble Beach.

Prohibited Activities in the Park

- Using golf equipment (including practice swings), and bringing jet skis, surfboards, windsurfing gear, or canoes is prohibited.
- Skateboarding is only allowed in RinX-SQUARE (the designated skateboarding area).
- Please do not enter the park with vehicles or motorcycles without permission.
- Please do not swim in the inner bay or fish using hooks.
- Please do not use open fires or bring hazardous materials into the park.
- Please do not fly unmanned aerial vehicles such as drones. (Generally prohibited)

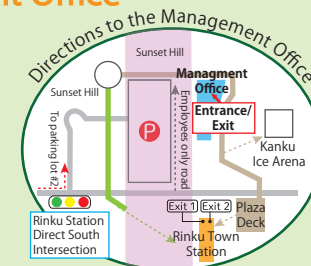

Rest Area

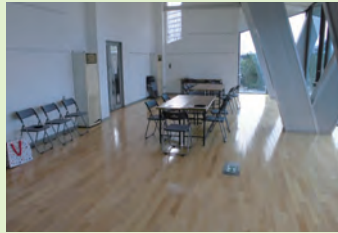

Fun Facts About Rinku Park

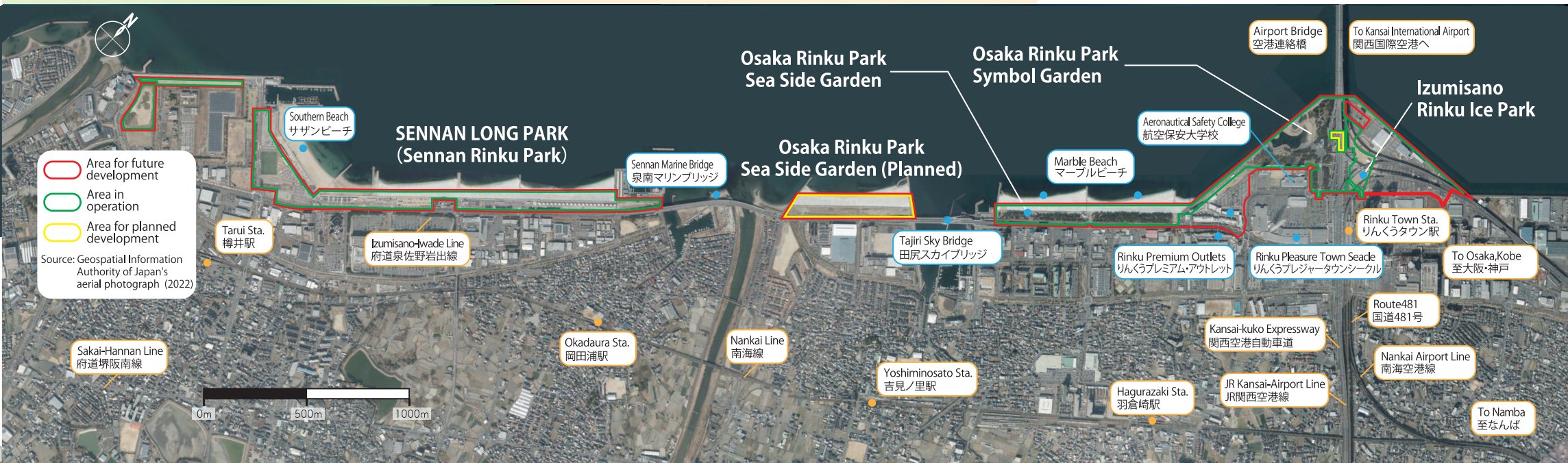
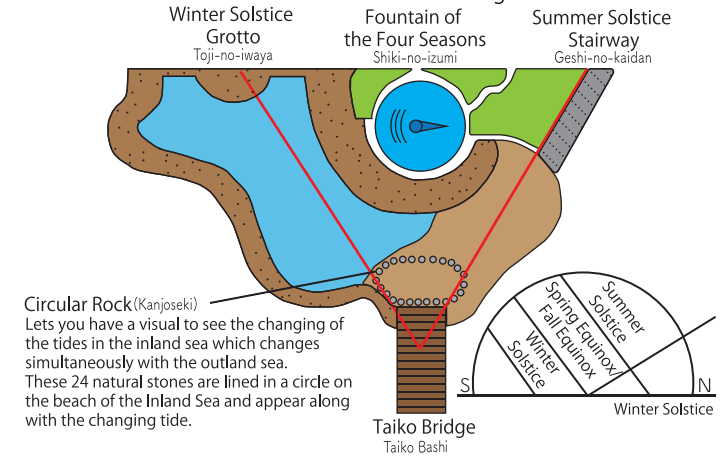
You can observe the diurnal path of the sun from the Taiko Bridge

On the Spring Equinox and Fall Equinox you can look directly west from the Taiko Bridge and see the sun set behind the Fountain of the Four Seasons.
On the Summer Solstice, the sun sets slightly north of the Fountain of the Four Seasons at the "Summer Solstice Stairway." While on the Winter Solstice, the sun will set slightly south of the Fountain of the Four Seasons at the "Winter Solstice Grotto."

The Motif of the Fountain of the Four Seasons

The Fountain of the Four Seasons has 3 large rings that when viewed from the Taiko Bridge on the left side represent the diurnal paths of the sun during the "Winter Solstice," "Spring and Fall Equinoxes," and "Summer Solstice." In other words, the seasonal orbit of the sun.
The central sphere represents the "Earth" and the tip of the thin pole extending outward represents the "Earth's Axis." This axis is pointing northward, which you can check because it points to the North Star.
Furthermore, the latitude of this location, 34 degrees 41 minutes, is marked by the angle of this axis.

Inland Sea 内海



Play in the sand and meet crabs, small fish and other sea life!
In the calm, sheltered inner bay, seasonal SUP and paddle boat rentals are available.
(Free rentals for water shoes and life jackets are also available.)

LOVE RINKu(Lovers' Sanctuary) LOVE RINKu (恋人の聖地)

LOVE RINKu, known as a sacred place for lovers, is a place where you can hang up a heart-shaped plate with your name or a message written in marker. Plates are sold at the 'Rinku Machidokoro Shop,' located directly in front of the ticket gates at Rinku-Town Station.
You can do things like gaze into the distance with the binoculars or use the camera stand to take a commemorative photo!



The Flowering Path 花海道



Over 50 species of flowers are blooming along this approximate 100m walking path.

Sea Side Garden

The Street to the Sea 海への道



It's a street connecting Rinku Town station to the park.
There are vibrant flowers welcoming park guests on both sides of the street.

RinX-SQUARE (Skateboarding Park)

The plaza's nickname, RinX-SQUARE, was created by combining "rink" (as in a sports arena), "X" (extreme sports), and "square." Skateboarding, inline skating, BMX, and other activities can be enjoyed by people of all ages and genders, providing opportunities for interaction and fun.
Please follow the rules and use the facility with consideration and cooperation.



The park features a spacious open area, with artificial turf in the center where you can relax!
Another unique feature is that areas lit by the sun change depending on the season.
Bringing in obstacles or similar equipment is prohibited. Please feel free to use the cones provided by the park management office.

Fountain of the Four Seasons 四季の泉

The three large rings, when viewed from the Taiko Bridge, represent the diurnal paths of the sun during the "Winter Solstice," "Spring and Fall Equinoxes," and "Summer Solstice." The central sphere represents the "Earth" and the tip of the thin pole extending outward represents the "Earth's Axis."



Taiko Bridge • Ishibutai 太鼓橋・石舞台



It's a large Taiko bridge with a pleasant wooden appearance.
In March 2025, this was reborn as "Shin Taikobashi (New Drum Bridge)!"
From the drum bridge, you can enjoy views of the fountain that changes its appearance with the seasons, as well as sunsets and airplanes, and experience events such as music festivals and performances held at the stone stage.



Marble Beach マーブルビーチ

A beach with a dazzling contrast of white round stones and the blue sea.
The sky, sea, and beach weave together to bring the various scenes of the seasons to everyone.
A new landmark monument, nicknamed "Sorutama" was completed in March 2025.

BBQ Area バーベキュー場

The BBQ area in the seaside green space offers magnificent scenery.
All facilities, including charcoal disposal areas, cooking areas, and washing stations are available free of charge.
Charcoal, lighters, and fire starters are sold at the parking office for a limited time and in limited quantities.



⚠ Important Notes
Barbecuing is only allowed at the BBQ site and in designated areas within Marble Beach.
Please bring your own BBQ equipment and ingredients.
Please refrain from using the facility at night. / Please refrain from staying overnight.

⚠ Prohibited Activities
Do not have barbecue on the sand or on the stairs. / Do not leave items to reserve spots.
Do not leave trash behind. / Do not play loud music.
Do not use open fires for barbecuing. (Please use the designated grills.)
Rinku Park is a park that values its scenic location. The area may be closed in the event of incidents such as littering or openfires.
Please follow the rules and be considerate so everyone can enjoy their time comfortably.

Marble Beach Monument マーブルビーチ モニュメント

This monument (nicknamed "Sorutama") is based on the concept of "Beyond the Clouds" and is designed for visitors to interpret and experience it in their own way.
Enjoy how its atmosphere changes throughout the day!



Boardwalk ボードウォーク

It's a wooden path that allows park visitors using wheelchairs to get closer access to the water.
